### **MR. DALE HENDRICK JOINS THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**Rouyn-Noranda, September 3, 2002.** Radisson Mining Resources Inc. (*Radisson*) is pleased to announce that Mr. Dale Hendrick, a renowned consultant from Toronto, has just joined the board of directors of the company.

Mr. Hendrick is President of Dale M. Hendrick and Associates of Toronto, a mining geological consulting firm. Mr. Hendrick is a geologist, and P.Eng.(Ont.), educated at Ottawa and Queen's universities and brings to the Board of *Radisson*, an outstanding forty-seven year reputation. He has a record of success in resource industry development, corporate finance and many years of executive and director experience with public companies listed on senior exchanges.

Mr. Hendrick has been a technical advisor to many major Toronto Stock Exchange listed resource companies and has extensive experience in arranging substantial financings. He is a past chairman of the Toronto Branch of the Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy and was awarded a C.I.M. Fellowship in 1999. *Radisson* is a Canadian mining exploration company that is currently in the process of obtaining of capital for developing the O'Brien Property located in northwestern Québec. Radisson intends to develop and apply a new extraction technique, thermal fragmentation, in partnership with Rocmec International inc, on the gold-bearing quartz veins identified at the surface on the O'Brien Property. The development phase program is budgeted for 1.2 millions canadian dollars. If successful, this innovative approach could lead to a significant decrease in the production costs of this high grade narrow vein type deposit. A second phase is planned, which is a 17,000 tons surface bulk sample, and will be auto financed by the revenues generated. It will produce all the data for a feasibility study to decide upon underground development.
